Workshop VIRTUAL LAB

AT JNGEC, SUNDERNAGAR IN COLLABORATION WITH IIT ROORKEE



Introduction

Virtual Labs is a project initiated by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, under the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology. The project aims to provide remote access to Laboratories in various disciplines of Science and Engineering for students at all levels from undergraduate to research. A virtual lab workshop is organized by JNGEC, Sunder Nagar in collaboration with IIT Roorkee. Keynote speaker project assistant of virtual lab IIT Roorkee Mr. Chetan Dhiman Sir and Mr. Jasbir Singh Sir.

The chief guest on 2nd May 2023 was Dr. Champa Verma Mam (HOD of Applied Science and Humanities). The chief guest on 3rd May 2023 was Sh. SK Gautam (Joint Directorate of Technical Education Sunder Nagar).



Opening

The overall goal of the workshop was to introduce participants to the Virtual lab. The workshop provided guided instructions to participants. The workshop was opened at 10 am with the welcome statement by the coordinator of the virtual lab Mr. Ravi Kumar on behalf of Director cum Principal SP Guleria Sir. Afterward, the Project Assistant of Virtual Lab IIT Roorkee Mr. Chetan Dhiman thanked JNGEC for organizing the workshop. Sir introduced the students to the virtual lab.

Discussion

Sir gave us a brief introduction to NPTEL, NDLI, and Shodh Sindhu. NPTEL (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning), is a joint venture of the IITs and IISc, funded by the Ministry of Education (MoE) Government of India, and was launched in 2003. The National Digital Library of India is a virtual repository of learning resources that is not only just a repository with search/browse facilities but also provides a host of services containing textbooks, articles, videos, audiobooks, lectures, simulations, fiction, and all other kinds of learning media for the learners/users community. The MHRD, Govt of India has formed e-ShodhSindhu merging three consortia initiatives, namely UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium, NLIST, and INDEST-AICTE Consortium. Sir also told us about the importance of resumes, projects, and languages for Placements.
